

Doctor of Psychology (Psy.D.)

The School of Professional Psychology at Spalding University makes every effort to ensure state licensure information is current; however, state requirements may change. If you are planning to pursue a license as a psychologist in a specific state, we strongly recommend you contact the appropriate licensing entity in that state for information and guidance regarding licensure requirements before beginning our PsyD program. To the best of our knowledge, no Spalding SOPP graduate has been denied licensure in any state due to insufficiencies in the education or training we provide. As we are located in Kentucky, we ensure our PsyD program complies with all licensing requirements in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

In addition to educational requirements, all states require the completion of supervised predoctoral practicum hours and a predoctoral internship. These aspects are also required for the doctoral of psychology degree in clinical psychology at Spalding University. In addition to education and training requirements for the doctoral degree, however, many jurisdictions require post-doctoral professional experience for full licensure as well as the passage of the national licensure exam (EPPP Step 1, or Step 1 and 2). Some jurisdictions also require an oral examination of competency and a jurisprudence exam for licensure. These requirements are beyond the curricular requirements described in this disclosure as they occur after graduation. Further, many jurisdictions require a doctorate from an APA accredited program. Spalding's PsyD program is currently and has been continuously accredited by APA since 1980.
