## ADDITIONAL COSTS

In addition to the above direct costs, Spalding University estimates **\$625 per year for books** for full-time graduate students. Graduate students also pay a **\$150 Student Services Fee** (annual) that supports health and wellness services and education. Students in Masters of Social Work and all graduate Psychology work will add a **\$5/credit hour** technology fee. Students in the MSN program will add a **\$3/credit hour** technology fee. Entry Level Physical Therapy students will add a **\$100/semester** lab & tech fee.
